

## Participation Requirements

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Young sailor needs to be 9 to 18 years old and weighing at least 60lbs and feel comfortable around the water. Sailors need to be dropped off on time, on the point by the cranes, and picked up immediately after their class. They should bring a snack and a generous amount of liquids which can be stored in the refrigerator. All participants must wear a properly fitting life jacket at all times on the docks and boats! If you do not own a life jacket, one can be provided for you! Bring and wear sun block, sunglasses with retaining strap and/or a hat and towel. Sailors will be getting wet! Shoes are required to be worn at all times on the docks! Water-socks are recommended.

*All participants must behave in a respectful manner. This is an instructional program, to teach the fundamentals of sailing and is not an alternative to parental supervision. We reserve the right to dismiss any child, if they can not respect the basic rules of the club and/or the program. AND... Parents there is a 10 mph. speed limit on the property that must be obeyed! Also, please pick up your child promptly after his/her class.*

## Class Times and Schedule

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Each course is 5 days, Monday through Friday. Morning classes start at 8 am sharp and finish at 12 noon. Monday's class is mandatory for Novice sailors! Afternoon classes run from 1 pm to 5 pm. Students wanting to continue improving their skills are encouraged to return for another course, when space is available. A tuition fee will be required for additional classes.

## Boats

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Novice and Beginner classes will be taught in Prams. Intermediate classes will be taught in El Toros. Advanced classes will be taught in Flying Juniors (FJ's). The Stockton Sailing Club will provide these boats. If you have your own boat please let us know at registration.

## Insurance

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The grant from the State of California requires that all participants be covered by the appropriate insurance that specifically indemnifies the State and its Department of Boating and Waterways. The SSC's "Youth Membership" covers this insurance requirement. Youth Membership dues are \$15.00. The Youth Membership applies for the duration of the program and expires August 30, 2007.

## Enrollment

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When requesting enrollment, please be sure to list at least two weeks in which you can attend the program. A confirmation card will be sent with notification of which week(s) you are enrolled. We recommend that you return the *Learn to Sail* Application along with all fees to reserve your space as soon as possible.

## Registration

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Registration packages are available at the SSC office. Completed applications and fees will be accepted in the office and will be processed according to their postmark or received date. \* **Class availability will be on a first come first served basis.**

## Fees

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Class fees need to be paid in full and accompanied with completed application form to guarantee registration in the desired class(es). Any incomplete applications will be returned. Fees must be received ten days prior to the start date of the class. If classes fill up and your fees have not been received, your child will be moved on to a waiting list. *SSC members may charge fees to their accounts.* Make checks payable to the Stockton Sailing Club.

## Cancellations

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Cancellations need to be made as soon as possible in order to offer the opportunity to another young sailor. Any cancellation less than ten days prior to class will result in forfeiture of your fees unless SSC is able to place another sailor in that spot.

## The Waiver

In order that Child may participate in the SSC sailing program, I hereby release SSC and agree to hold SSC harmless from any and all claims for injuries or death suffered by Child, including those caused by negligence of SSC. I accept full responsibility for the cost of treatment for any injuries suffered by Child in connection with SSC's sailing program, or in transit to or from SSC.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, in the event suit or legal claim is brought by or on behalf of Child on account of injury or death in connection with SSC's sailing programs, I agree to indemnify SSC against any costs associated therewith, including settlement, judgement, attorney fees, court costs, and expert witness fees that may be incurred by SSC.

And in regards to the *Learn to Sail* program, I have read and understand the basic rules, fees, and expectations of the program and will make sure that Child also understands.
