

Participation Requirements

Young sailor needs to be 9 to 18 years old and weighing at least 60lbs and feel comfortable around the water. Sailors need to be dropped off on time, on the point by the cranes, and picked up immediately after their class. They should bring a snack and a generous amount of liquids which can be stored in the refrigerator. All participants must wear a properly fitting life jacket at all times on the docks and boats! If you do not own a life jacket, one can be provided for you! Bring and wear sun block, sunglasses with retaining strap and/or a hat and towel. Sailors will be getting wet! Shoes are required to be worn at all times on the docks! Water-socks are recommended.

*All participants must behave in a respectful manner. This is an instructional program, to teach the fundamentals of sailing and is not an alternative to parental supervision. We reserve the right to dismiss any child, if they can not respect the basic rules of the club and/or the program. **Parents:** There is a 10 mph. speed limit on the property that must be obeyed! Also, please pick up your child promptly after his/her class.*

Class Times and Schedule

Most courses are 5 days, Monday through Friday. Morning classes start at 8 am and finish at 12 noon! Afternoon classes run from 1 pm to 5 pm. In order for our students to gain as much out of each class as possible students need to arrive and depart **promptly**. Monday classes are mandatory for Novice sailors. Students wanting to continue to advance their skills are encouraged to return for another course. A tuition fee is required for each class and must be paid prior to the start of each new session.

Registration

Completed applications and fees will be accepted in the office **after** April 23, 2011 and will be processed in the order in which they are received. Class size(s) are limited and availability will be on a first come first served basis. We recommend that you return the **Learn to Sail** Application with the date(s) and class(s) selections as soon as possible. A confirmation card will be sent with notification of which week(s) you are enrolled. **** The Stockton Sailing Club reserves the right to change classes/levels based on the needs and abilities of Learn to Sail Participants and Instructors. Every effort will be made to reassign students to a comparable class with as much advance notice, as possible.**

Fees

Class fees must be paid in full and accompanied with completed application form to registration in the desired class(es). Incomplete applications will be returned. No partial payments will be accepted. *SSC members may charge fees to their accounts.* **Please make checks payable to the Stockton Sailing Club.** Note: Any returned checks will be charged an additional \$25.00 fee. Visa and Mastercard also accepted.

Cancellations

Any cancellation less than ten days prior to class start date will result in forfeiture of your fees.

The Waiver

I am the parent or legal guardian of _____, a minor ("child"). To induce the Stockton Sailing Club, it's employees, volunteers, agents, insurers, members, trustees, and officers (hereinafter "SSC") to promote the sport of sailing and make sailing opportunities available to young people, I freely and voluntarily enter into this Agreement.

I understand and acknowledge that the sport of sailing has inherent risks. These include physical injury and death by drowning or other means. I realize that negligence on the part of SSC in the organization or operation of youth sailing programs may cause or contribute to such injury or death. In order that Child may participate in the SSC sailing program, I hereby release SSC and agree to hold SSC harmless from any and all claims for injuries or death suffered by Child, including those caused by negligence of SSC. I accept full responsibility for the cost of treatment for any injuries suffered by Child in connection with SSC's sailing program, or in transit to or from SSC.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, in the event suit or legal claim is brought by or on behalf of Child on account of injury or death in connection with SSC's sailing programs, I agree to indemnify SSC against any costs associated therewith, including settlement, judgement, attorney fees, court costs, and expert witness fees that may be incurred by SSC.

And in regards to the **Learn to Sail** program, I have read and understand the basic rules, fees, and expectations of the program and will make sure that Child also understands. Should the participant be in need of medical treatment, my signature below confirms my permission for medical treatment to be done in the event that I cannot be reached promptly.
