

CASS OWINGS MEMORIAL
“CREWPERSON OF THE YEAR”
AWARD NOMINATION

This trophy is presented annually to the individual who best exemplifies the qualities that Cass Owings brought to the Stockton Sailing Club. Cass (Son of Paul Owings) died several years ago while free diving for abalone off of the Northern California Coast. He had been active in our racing program for years, primarily as crew on various boats. It is in his memory that the award is presented.

Stockton Sailing Club member skippers may nominate contenders for this trophy, who must have crewed aboard a SSC yacht in an SSC regatta, but the nominees do NOT have to be a member of this or any sailing club.

The judging criteria will include:

Dedication: Dedication to the boat, the captain, and the other crew over and above what is expected.

Reliability: Reliability in that this individual could be relied upon to not only “be there”, but to perform the job expected of a crewmember, and more.

Enthusiasm: Enthusiasm that contributed to the running of the boat and the enjoyment of the sport.

Sportsmanship: Displaying a spirit of goodwill and fairness regardless of the standing of the boat.
