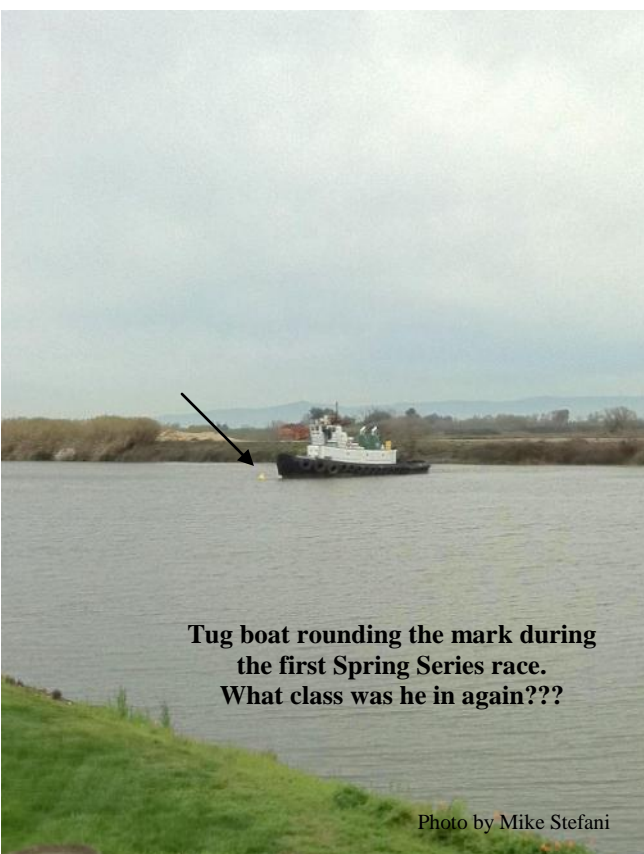
Attention all members!

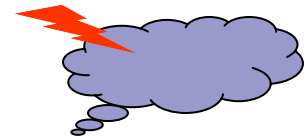

Tug boat rounding the mark during the first Spring Series race. What class was he in again???

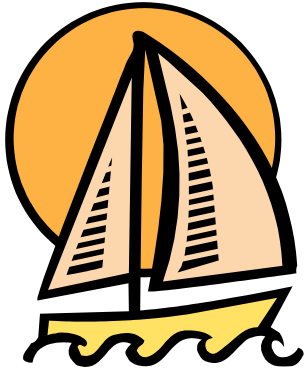

- I. Call to Order:** Commodore Abe Ayala called meeting to order at 6:35pm.

II. Standing Business

- a. Agenda:** Motion to approved March agenda. Moyer/Cahill M/S/P
- b. Minutes:** Motion to approve **amended** February minutes. Gibson/Cahill M/S/P
- c. Financial Statements:**
Approval of February financials delayed until special meeting on 03/29/2011, due to Peter Hines' absence. Gibson/Moyer M/S/P
- d. Club Manager Report:** Gate control and front door to be repaired. Upgrade to the marina computer program in progress in order to upgrade POS program. Again the call to take possession of multiple outboard motors before they are put up for sale. There will be notices in the next Dock Talk and possibly in the monthly bills. Bathroom and kitchen tile grout are being deep cleaned.
- e. Correspondence:** Dave Van Dyke, Stuart Gregor and Bobby Doscher have requested use of the retreat. Wes Wallstrom is hoping to find someone to accompany him to PICYA meetings. Moyer/Cahill M/S/P
- f. Member and Guest Comments:** Tom Lueck proposed that the annual cost of living raise for employees' be suspended in view of the economic time.

III. Old Business: New bar coolers have been ordered and the expected delivery date will be approximately 4/07/11. The cost for both coolers and delivery will be \$4,000.00.

IV. New Business : Approval of the budget for 2012 has been delayed until the special meeting on 3/29/11 and Peter Hines' attendance. Discussion on the Learn To Sail program will also be addressed. That Commodore appoint one or more board members to provide support for the Learn-to-Sail program through the following actions: 1. Draft bylaw changes to establish LTS as a distinct program similar to the Regatta, Social and Junior programs, 2. Develop a detailed budget for FYE 2012 and gain approval of that budget from FBLI, and 3. Work with the Harbormaster to develop hiring guidelines for a program administrator for program.
